Our Leadership



Belkis Fernandez started working with the needy in her native Dominican Republic when she was 17 years old.

While studying social work at university, she traveled across her homeland assisting those in need and emphasizing the development of programs to assist abused and abandoned women and other areas of social impact.

For 10 years she worked with the Ministry of Agriculture, after which she became involved in development projects for communities along Dominican-Haitian border.

She completed her Master's Degree in Advanced Education at the Autonomous University of Santo Domingo in 1995 and became Director of the School of Rural Development at the National Evangelical University.

Belkis traveled across Central and South America as part of her work for World Vision and Food for the Hungry Dominican Republic.

In Canada, she worked for Canadian Food for the Hungry for 9 years. Belkis has been employed at the Yorktown shelter for abused women in Toronto since 1998. She is also the Pastor of the First Spanish Church of the Nazarene in Woodbridge and the main founder of Manantial Neighbourhood Services.
